Install Zoom

1. Install Zoom onto your laptop

A. Check if you already have the Zoom application installed on your computer.

- **Windows:** Navigate to Start > Scroll Start Menu to Zoom folder > Click "Start Zoom."
- **Macintosh:** Launch Finder > navigate to your Applications Folder > Zoom application listed.

B. Download Zoom directly from any of the following links:

C. Follow the download instructions that appear on your screen once you click one of the links above.

2. Install Zoom onto your tablet/phone

A. Open the application store on your device

- Apple: App Store
- Android: Google Play

B. Search "Zoom" in the search bar and download "ZOOM Cloud Meetings".

C. "Zoom" in the search bar and **download** "ZOOM Cloud Meetings."

D. The icon will appear on your home screen

Sign into Zoom with the Email Address You Provided on Your Registration Form

1. **Check email:** An invitation has been sent to the email used to register
2. This invitation is unique to you. You can also add to your calendar.

MUTE

Participants are muted upon entering the meeting to prevent unintentional disruptions during the presentation. *Participants please remain on mute for the duration of the presentation, additional instructions will be provided during the presentation regarding asking questions.*

BE ON TIME

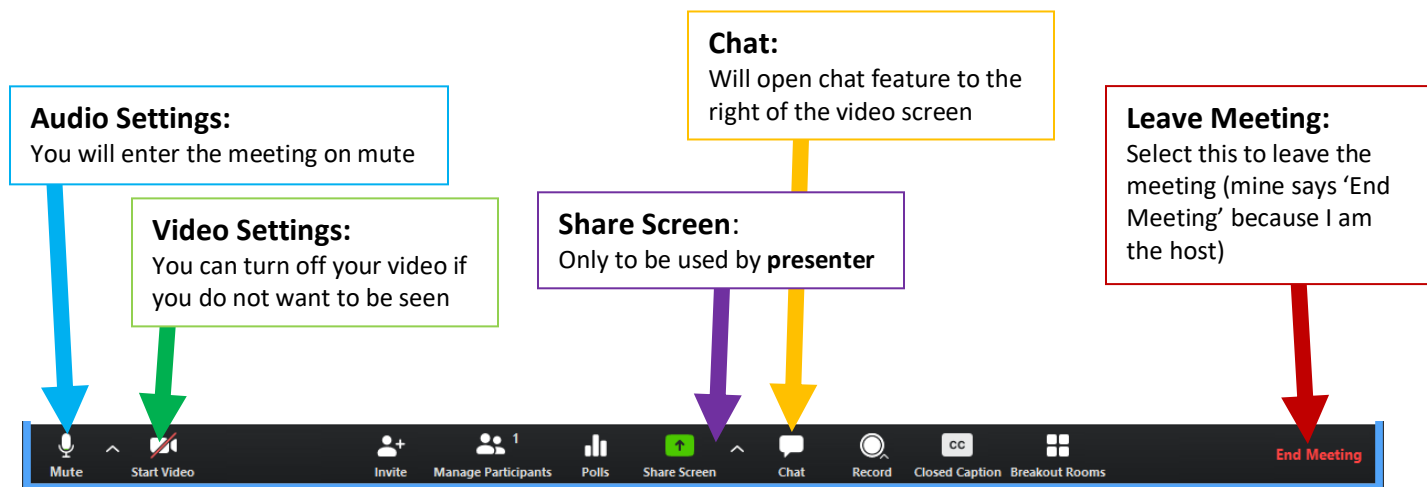
Please join the meeting on time or up to **15 minutes** prior to the start time.

CHAT: You may need to use the chat “everyone” feature in Zoom

The chat box can be opened by clicking the “Chat” button in the menu bar at the bottom of your screen. You may have to move your cursor over the Zoom meeting window to see the menu bar.

Zoom Menu Options

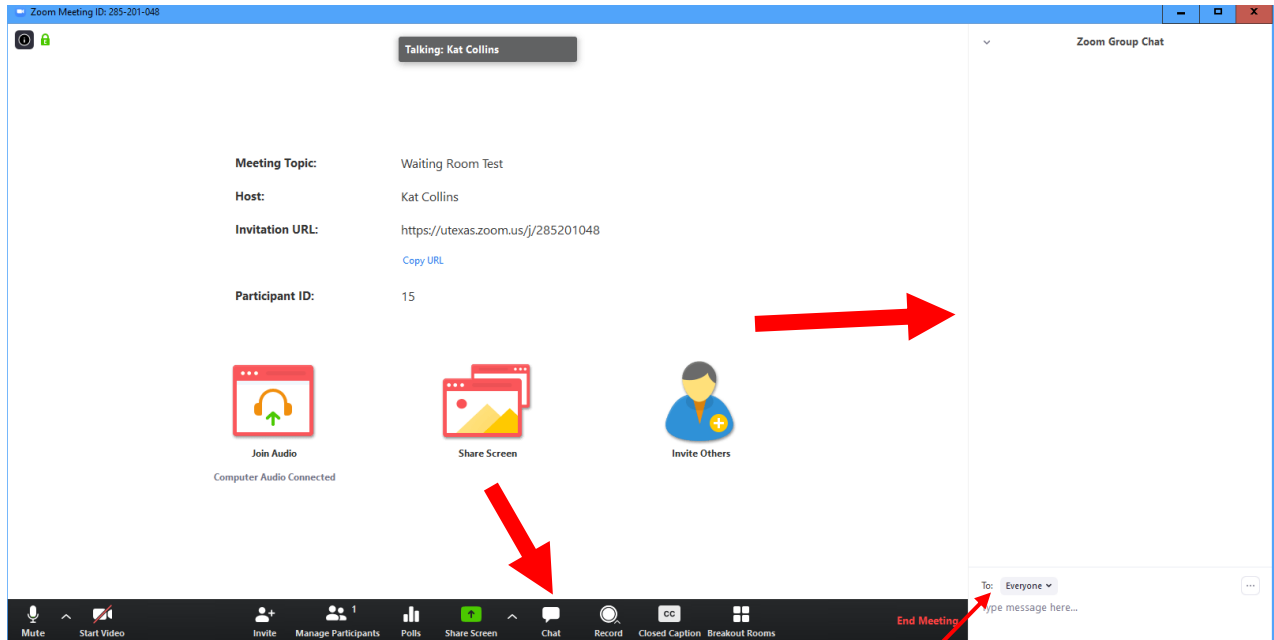
You may have to move your cursor to the bottom of the Zoom meeting window to see the menu bar



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Asking Questions at the Meeting

1. Following each speaker's presentation, the speaker will review all questions that are posted by the audience in the Chat feature, select the questions he or she chooses to answer, repeat the question to the audience and answer
2. How to ask your question in “Chat.”
At the bottom center of your Zoom window, you will see a menu. Clicking the “Chat” button will make a chat box appear in the right of your window. Type your question in the chat text box, direct it to “everyone” and press “Enter”.



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
